## Our Alpaca Connection Tour has been thoughtfully designed to provide a relaxed, engaging, and memorable animal experience for disability groups.

We understand that every group has unique needs, so our friendly team delivers the tour at a comfortable pace, creating plenty of opportunities for meaningful interaction, questions, and photos. Our calm, well-trained llamas are experienced standing alongside wheelchairs, making it easy for guests to enjoy gentle, close-up encounters.

The 45-minute experience includes an educational introduction to alpacas and llamas, a special meet-and-greet with one of our beautiful llamas, and a hand-feeding session with our friendly herd. Where required, we can adapt the experience so everyone has the opportunity to participate and enjoy connecting with our animals.

Whether you're visiting with a day program, support organisation, or community group, our goal is to create a fun, inclusive, and heartwarming experience that everyone can enjoy

# Accessibility

## Zero Entry Door Footpaths

Access to our Farm Shop, Cafe and toilets is via a zero entry door, which is a barrier free threshold. Zero entry doors make access easier for those with wheelchairs, walking frames or mobility concerns. We have concrete footpaths from the carpark to the front of our building. We also have a large undercover patio area with concrete floors and wide concrete pathway, easily accessible from our Farm Shop.

## Accessible Toilets

Within our Farm Shop we have two accessible toilets:  
Ambulant Toilet – specifically designed for individuals with ambulant disabilities that do not require the amount of space that an accessible toilet offers (such as a walking frame user).  
Accessible Toilet – specifically designed to provide space for wheelchair access and assistance. Includes lower mirror and wash basin, grab rails, different toilet seat colour and braille signage.

## Wheelchair Access

We have flat concrete paths from the Wheelchair Accessible Carpark, around and to the front of our Farm Shop and to and from our undercover entertaining patio area.

Our paddocks and picnic areas are flat and are wheelchair accessible when weather permits.

Where guests have booked an alpaca tour, and accessibility is a concern, we will bring one of our alpacas or llamas to the building/formed path.

## Assistance Dogs

Certified Assistance Dog who have completed their training are permitted on our farm and within our Farm Shop at any time. Pet dogs are not permitted.

Please notify the farm in advance if you are bringing an Assistance Dog to an alpaca tour to enable us to make the suitable arrangements/changes to the tour.

# Additional Information

- **Our Farm:** we are located in Murrumbateman, which is about a 30 minute drive from Canberra, the capital of Australia.
- **Our Address:** 315 Patemans Lane, Murrumbateman, NSW.
- **Directions to our Farm:** from Canberra, follow the Barton Highway. Turn right into Euroka Ave and travel to the end of the avenue. At the t-intersection turn right into Patemans Lane. We are located at the very end of Patemans Lane. Follow the gravel driveway and park at the Farm Shop carpark. It is the large charcoal building on your right. Note: Do not take Gooda Creek Rd turn off as this road does not connect with the farm. Please park in the carpark and not on the grass as our alpacas and llamas graze on the grass.
- **Visiting Times:** Disability groups are welcome during our public open hour (Friday - Sunday from 10am to 4pm) however visits can be arranged outside of these days. Note: we are closed to all visitors Monday and Tuesdays).
- **Car and Bus Parking:** large gravel carpark with bus access and parking available.
- **Cafe:** we have an on-site cafe, with a range of inside seating options, serving barista coffee, tea, hot chocolate, milkshakes, toasted sandwiches, grazing platters and a selection of homemade cakes and slices, during public open days. If catering is required outside of our public opening days, please reach out to make prior arrangements. Clients are permitted to bring their own food, however carers and support personal must purchase from our cafe.





- **Seating:** Indoor and outdoor (undercover large patio) seating options are available. Picnic tables and large grass areas in front of the Farm Shop for more casual dining.
- **Confirmation of Group Numbers:** final guest list and all dietary requirements are required 7 days prior to event.
- **Payment:** a 20% non-refundable deposit is required at time of booking with the remainder due 7 days prior to visit.
